The Need for Training

The Department of Health's 'Safer Maternity Care' report (Nov, 2017) outlined, in detail, the national strategy to achieve the 'Maternity Safety Ambition' of halving stillbirths, neonatal and maternal deaths, and brain injuries by 2025. It stated that the ambition will not be achieved "*unless the rate of preterm births is reduced*", with a further ambition set out to reduce preterm births from 8% to 6%.

Course Content

Our course directors are leaders in the field with national and international reputations, and frontline professionals, with the intention to provide interactive sessions on:

- Reducing smoking in pregnancy.
- Risk assessment, prevention and surveillance of pregnancies at risk of fetal growth restriction.
- Raising awareness of reduced fetal movement.
- Reducing preterm births.
- Quality improvement, metrics, and guideline implementation
- Guidelines to reduce preterm birth.
- Guidelines to raise awareness, and improve management of reduced fetal movement.
- Guidelines for assessment, surveillance, and management of pregnancies at risk of fetal growth restriction.

Please note: The course does not address technical aspects of scanning, multiple pregnancies or pregnancies with fetal abnormalities. Hands-on technical ultrasound training will not be part of this course.
